HOW TO GET THERE

From the South: Go through Levin towards Foxton. Continue past the Waitarere Beach turn off & stay on the main highway. Just past the sign for Mitchpine, take the first road on your left – Oturoa Road. Go down this road until you see the markers for ride base.

From the North: Go through Foxton & over the Foxton Bridges. Approx 2km after the bridges, turn right into Oturoa Road. Go down this road until you see the markers for ride base.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Horses in the Championship Classes must be 5 years & older.

Horses & riders must both be qualified (either individually or as a combination) in 2 x WATRC rides in the current season in the classes they wish to compete in (note: qualifying rides must have 30 or less time faults for novice, mbt, junior & intermediate & 20 or less time faults for the open class).

Riders must have been WATRC members at the time of qualifying.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR NON CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS

No qualification criteria for Non Championship class other than horses must be 4 years or older.
